



Rendering of I-405 looking northwest at Springdale St. overcrossing




### **Project Description**



The project adds 1 general purpose and 1 express lane. The express lane, when combined with the existing carpool lane, creates the I-405 Express Lanes, a two-lane each direction express facility similar to the 91 Express Lanes.

### **Documented Public Input**

#### Public Comment During Environmental Review

- Extensive public comment received through national/state mandated process for environmental review. Large volume of comments:
  - 5 Public Hearings with 900 attendees
  - 1,463 public comments
- Public comments include direct input from OCTA Bike/Ped Subcommittee Members, including in-person meetings directly with Chair Shahbazian and others at following dates:
  - June 8, 2012
  - December 18, 2012
  - May 2, 2013






