




# Phasing




## Districts 1 & 2 Strategy

# Draft District 5 Goals

- Goal #1: <u>Increase the use</u> of bicycle as a viable alternative to the automobile
- Goal #2: <u>Coordinate</u> regional bikeways planning and construction among individual cities
- Goal #3: Build a bicycle transportation network by planning, designing, and maintaining transportation facilities that will meet the needs for <u>all types of bicyclists</u>
- Goal #4: Improve bicycling <u>safety</u> in the district
