Active Transportation Program (ATP)

- Cycle 5 ATP applications are currently under review by MPOs
- Interim Timely Use of Funds policy
 - Contract Award is now extended from 6 months to 12 months after allocation. This includes projects allocated between Oct 2019 – Jun 2020.
 - The MAXIMUM time extension for project delivery milestones have been extended from 12 months to 20 months.
 - If you requested a time extension of 12 months before the interim policy was implemented, you may request the additional 8 months.

Inactive Invoices

- The current inactive quarter began January 1, 2021
- February 23, 2021 Deadline for invoice submittals for this quarter
- If your agency has invoices on FHWA's official inactive list, <u>this will</u> jeopardize your funding.
- We are aware of difficulties agencies may have in processing invoices due to COVID-19. If you have any questions or issues with submitting invoices, please work with your area engineer/planner for further assistance.

Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) HSIP Cycle 10 applications are currently under review Reviews should be done in the next few weeks HSIP Cycle 11 will be open for applications in May 2022 to be eligible for Cycle 11, project needs to incorporate LRSP or equivalent reports such as systemic safety analysis report (SSARP) LRSP has 4 E's (Engineering, Enforcement, Education, and Emergency Services), and a stakeholder group needs to be formed SSARP only develops engineering countermeasures

Bridge Program (HBP)

- HBP currently does not have sufficient funding for new projects, and for AC conversions
- Most AC conversions will have to be pushed to future years
- HBP managers have developed a list of priority projects which have been sent out to local agencies previously

Title VI

- Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 prohibits discrimination by recipient of Federal assistance on the basis of race, color, and national origin, including the denial of meaningful access for limited English proficient (LEP) Persons.
- Requirements include but are not limited to:
 - Title VI nondiscrimination statement
 - Assurances (as part of the Master Agreement and Program Supplement Agreement.
 - Designation of a Title VI Coordinator.
 - Complaint Procedures.
 - Data Collection.
 - Training.
 - Dissemination of Information.
 - Contracts and Agreements.
 - Environmental Justice.
 - Public Hearings and Meetings.
 - Right of Way activities.
 - Construction contract compliance.
 - Monitoring.
- Caltrans has also recently updated our webpage on Filing a Complaint, and it provides guidance to local agencies on how to process Title VI complaints.
