The City of Fullerton and the Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA) built a vehicle undercrossing at the intersection of State College Boulevard and the Burlington Northern Santa Fe Railway. The roadway was lowered between Santa Fe Avenue to the north to approximately 500 feet south of Valencia Drive to the south. The State College Blvd. undercrossing is one fo seven grade separations within the OC Bridges Program.

This project was funded by OC Go (also known as Measure M), a 30-year half-cent sales tax for transportation improvements in Orange County through 2041. After experiencing the success and progress of M1, nearly 71% of Orange County voters renewed the half-cent sales tax for transportation improvements to launch OC Go in 2011. In addition to OC Go funding, this project received funding from state sources.
