Enabling Legislation

In late 2013, California State Legislature adopted Assembly Bill 401 (AB 401)

Assembly Bill 401 Summary

- Sections 6820 6829 of California Public Contract Code
- Section 91.2 of the Streets and Highways Code
- Provides OCTA authority to use design-build delivery method on the Interstate 405 Improvement Project (and other projects)
- Outlines the procurement process requirements



Two Step Process


First Step = Request for Qualifications (RFQ)

- Minimum RFQ requirements included in AB 401
- Short-list based on Statement of Qualifications
- Second Step = Request for Proposals (RFP)
 - Minimum RFP requirements included in AB 401
 - Contract award based on best value
 - For best value procurements, AB 401 stipulates minimum factors to be utilized for weighting
 - Price
 - Technical
 - Life-cycle costs
