

Project Purpose



- Reduce congestion

- Minimize environmental impacts and ROW acquisition



Significant Project Features

405 PROJECT

- Two new lanes in each direction (one GP and one tolled express lane)
- 18 structure replacements (bridges) plus new and widened structures
- Interchange reconfigurations
- Auxiliary lane improvements
- Arterial improvements
- Drainage improvements
- Anticipated 5.5-year design-build contract duration
- ❖ Project cost is approximately \$1.9 Billion










Travel Time Benefits Comparison

Express Lanes Goals

- Providing express lanes customers with a safe, reliable, predictable commute.
- Optimizing throughput at free-flow speeds.
- Increase average vehicle occupancy
- Balance capacity and demand to serve customers who pay tolls as well as people who rideshare or use transit.
- Generating sufficient revenue to sustain the financial viability of the express lanes.
- Ensuring all covenants in the financing documents are met.
- Ensuring any potential net excess toll revenues are used for Interstate 405 corridor improvements.
