








I-405 Project Location





Project Need

- Both general purpose (GP) and high occupancy vehicle (HOV) traffic exceeds available capacity
- GP lanes have operational and geometric deficiencies
- Interchanges have geometric, storage, and operational deficiencies
- Limitations in detecting, rapidly responding to, and quickly clearing traffic accidents from traffic lanes



General Project Improvements



- Builds bridges, overcrossings to Master Plan of Arterial Highways standards
- Improves local streets and on/off ramps
- Adds bike lanes and sidewalks
- Maintains or improves existing sound walls
- Constructs additional sound walls



Build Alternatives


Alt.	General Description	Cost Estimate
1*	Add one general purpose (GP) lane each direction (Measure M2 Project K)	\$1.3 billion
2	Add two GP lanes each direction	\$1.4 billion
3	Add one GP lane and one high-occupancy toll (HOT)/express lane	\$1.7 billion






Supplemental Draft EIR/EIS

- Caltrans Fair Share formula

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% Share = Additional Traffic Due to the Project (Traffic with Project – Existing Traffic)
