Be Sure to Take Your Transponder on the 91 Express Lanes

As you travel through Orange County, you may have noticed some differences in the way payment is collected for toll roads. In May, for example, the Transportation Corridor Agencies (TCA) removed all cash and coin collection machines from the network of roads that includes the Foothill (State Route 241), the San Joaquin Hills (State Route 73), and the Eastern (State Routes 241, 133 and 261) transportation corridors.

This follows TCA's introduction earlier this year of Express Accounts, a program that allows drivers to travel on TCA toll roads without a FasTrak® when signing up transponder. Toll rates with Express Accounts are Express Lanes.

Confused about what these changes may mean on the 91 Express Lanes? No worries! Just continue to use your FasTrak transponder. Vehicles must be equipped with a FasTrak transponder linked to a pre-paid account to use the 91 Express Lanes. When traveling through

the toll zone, the transponder is read and the posted toll amount is automatically deducted from your pre-paid account. Your FasTrak transponder can also be used when traveling on other California toll facilities such as the SR-125 and I-15 Express Lanes in San Diego and San Francisco-Oakland Bay Bridge and Golden Gate Bridge in the San Francisco Bay Area.

On the 91 Express Lanes, save an average of 30 minutes per trip* while traveling in free-flowing lanes for 10 miles without stopping to pay tolls. Transponders are available by mail or in person when signing up for an account for the 91 Express Lanes.

Progress Continues as the 91Express Lanes Extends into Riverside County



Known as the 91 Project, the extension of the 91 Express Lanes into Riverside County is moving forward. Led by the Riverside County Transportation Commission (RCTC), the SR-91 Project will add regular lanes, tolled express lanes, auxiliary lanes and a direct express lane connector from northbound Interstate 15

(I-15) to westbound State Route 91 (SR-91) and eastbound SR-91 to southbound I-15. Improvements to interchanges, bridges, ramps, and local streets will also be made along SR-91.

Over the past few months, crews have concentrated on work outside the 91 roadway. In March, tree removal began in accordance with a Tree Preservation and Removal Plan prepared by a certified arborist as part of RCTC's commitment to sustainable approaches on its infrastructure projects. Trees will be replaced at a ratio of 1.25 trees for every one removed; oak trees will be replaced at a ratio of three trees replaced for every one tree removed.

In the second half of 2014, major work along SR-91 will focus on widening along the

shoulder, bridge reconstruction and ramp reconfiguration and reconstruction. Work along I-15, from SR-91/I-15 interchange to Ontario Avenue, will focus on widening in between the median. The eastbound SR-91 to southbound I-15 connector, the northbound I-15 to westbound SR-91 connector and improvements to SR-91/State Route 71 (SR-71) connector also are expected to begin construction this year.

Please be aware of all construction-related activity along the project corridor and remember to slow down, watch for workers and heavy equipment and allow extra travel time.

New Toll Adjustments Effective July 1, 2014

Each year, tolls not adjusted by congestion management pricing are subject to a cost of living adjustment (COLA) as specified by the toll policy approved by the OCTA Board of Directors. Beginning July 1, tolls will increase 3% (rounded up or down to the nearest 0.05 cent increment).
