SR-91 Eastbound Lane Addition Project

Release Date: December 18, 2009

Eastbound SR-91 Nighttime Lane Closures from SR-55 to SR-71 December 21 - December 23, 2009

WHAT: As part of the Riverside Freeway (SR-91) Eastbound Lane Addition Project, nighttime work will take place December 21 through December 23, 2009 to grind pavement and set concrete barriers, or “K” rail, from the SR-241 interchange to the SR-71.

The pavement grinding and “K” rail placement are necessary to perform work in this area and to allow space for construction workers to build a new eastbound lane safely and efficiently during day and nighttime hours. SR-91 will remain open to drivers; however, some lanes will be closed during off-peak/nighttime hours to complete work. Nighttime work on this particular stretch of SR-91, between SR-241 and SR-71, will be ongoing through the end of 2010.

PROJECT BENEFITS: The new SR-91 Eastbound Lane Addition Project will:

- Add a new 12-foot eastbound lane with a 12-foot shoulder to a key stretch of SR-91
- Realign the eastbound SR-91/northbound SR-71 connector to improve operations
- Widen five bridges and construct 10 new retaining walls
- Reconstruct the on- and off-ramps at Green River Road
- Environmental stewardship
