- Standardized 12-foot lanes and 10-foot right shoulders
- Widened undercrossing at Weir Canyon Road/ Yorba Linda Boulevard and Imperial Highway in the westbound and eastbound directions
- New restriping throughout project limits
- Soundwall on eastbound side of the freeway along key residential area
