Education and Encouragement

Office of Traffic Safety funding:

- Bicycle and pedestrian skills training and safety materials:
 - Themed bicycle classes
 - Distribution of pedestrian safety lights at OC Bus stops
 - Distribution of bicycle helmets/lights at pop up events



Safety

Two key efforts underway:

- Safe Routes to School (SRTS) Action Plan
 - Evaluates countywide efforts and recommends actions to increase reach
 - Will create a strategic plan for a countywide SRTS Program
- Safe Travels Education Program (STEP)
 Campaign
 - Education and encouragement activities at 25 disadvantaged area schools countywide
- Both efforts in collaboration with the Orange County Health Care Agency



Project :


- Goals
 - Develop an action plan to guide the development of a countywide safe routes to school program
 - Hold events to get community input and feedback
 - Conduct SRTS activities at schools within the County
- Next Steps
 - Planning and continuing with fall outreach activities, to be done remotely
 - Drafting Action Plan
 - CAC/Bike Ped Committee will receive draft



Safe Travels Education Program

Project initiation

- Kicked off in January 2020
- Completed school screening criteria
- Recruitment for 25 schools for fall 2020
 campaign activities
- Developing Fall Activities
 - Virtual walking and biking education modules that fit within the physical education curriculum guidelines
- Project completion in June 2022



System Evaluation

Cyclic counts

- Bidirectional counts at 100 locations, including on- and off-street facilities
- May 2020 and 2021 (weekday/Saturday)
 - Video counts
 - Counts include use type and direction




Example of count camera, Counts Unlimited



System Evaluation (continued)

OC Bike Map

- Previously updated in 2015
- Bike facilities background data updated for 2020 map
- Feedback from cities in process
- Completion in September 2020




Bike to Work Week

- Challenges Planned for September
- Will have alternative activities for those working from home
- Will have giveaways to encourage participation and engagement



Bicycle Gap Closure Study

- \$200,000 project running from Spring 2021-Spring 2023
- Assessment to close bikeway gaps for a Central and Southern Loop and a Cross-County Connector bikeway
- Recommend cost-effective solutions for a continuous and high-quality bikeway network
- Develop grant-ready cost estimates, positioning cities for funding pursuits or utilization of local funds to advance bikeways projects



Next Steps

- Return with updates on active transportation efforts including:
 - Progress on SRTS planning and program efforts
 - Partnering with local agencies to implement active transportation projects
- Seek funding opportunities to support active transportation activities
 - Continue working with local agencies and community groups to advance active transportation measures for all Orange County residents
 - Continue to monitor novel coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic and adapt activities to accommodate safe protocols
