METROLINK OVERVIEW

Metrolink is Southern California's commuter rail service linking residential communities to employment and activity centers. Three Metrolink lines serve Orange County:

- Orange County (OC) Line from Oceanside to Los Angeles Union Station
- Inland Empire-Orange County (IEOC) Line from San Bernardino and Riverside to Oceanside
- 91/Perris Valley (91/PV) Line from Riverside to Los Angeles via Fullerton and Buena Park

Weekend service is available on all three lines, excluding the Perris Valley Extension of the 91/PV Line.

ABOUT METROLINK

Formed in 1991, Metrolink is operated by the Southern California Regional Rail Authority (SCRRA), a joint powers authority consisting of five member agencies representing the counties of Los Angeles, Orange, Riverside, San Bernardino, and Ventura. The Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA) is one of the five member agencies and administers Orange County Metrolink activities.
