BACKGROUND

The Irvine train station has been serving Amtrak and Metrolink passengers since it opened in 1990. Today nearly 2,000 passengers board Metrolink and Amtrak trains from the Irvine station each weekday, and is one of the most heavily used stations in Orange County.

STATION HIGHLIGHTS

- Located near premier shopping destinations and employment centers in Irvine, Lake Forest, Aliso Viejo and Laguna Hills
- On-site restaurant
- Public restrooms
- Comfortable waiting area equipped with benches and shaded structures
- Pedestrian bridge with elevator
- Information kiosk and automated ticket vending machine
- Enhanced security features
- Transit/shuttle service to adjacent employment and activity centers
- 1,500 space parking structure in addition to surface lot parking
- Overnight parking allowed
