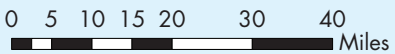

## Amtrak Coast Starlight®

Amtrak long distance train service between Los Angeles, Oakland, Portland, Seattle and intermediate stations.



## Amtrak Pacific Surfliner®

Amtrak intercity train service between San Diego, Los Angeles, Santa Barbara, San Luis Obispo and intermediate stations.



## COASTER

Commuter train service between Oceanside and San Diego and intermediate stations.



## Metrolink

Commuter train service with seven routes serving Los Angeles, Orange, Ventura, Riverside, San Bernardino, and San Diego counties.

### Amtrak Ticket Information

Advanced reservations required. Tickets may be purchased by visiting [Amtrak.com](http://Amtrak.com), by calling 1-800-USA-RAIL, or by visiting any staffed Amtrak station.

Amtrak accepts cash, MasterCard, Visa, American Express, Discover, and debit cards with a credit card logo at all staffed ticket offices. Debit cards requiring a PIN are not accepted.

### Amtrak Coast Starlight Holiday Service

The Amtrak Coast Starlight operates daily including all holidays.

### Amtrak Ticket Information

Amtrak tickets may be purchased by visiting [Amtrak.com](http://Amtrak.com), at Amtrak Quik-Trak™ self-serve kiosks, Metrolink/Amtrak ticket vending machines (for Pacific Surfliner only, advance reservations required for all other Amtrak trains), by calling 1-800-USA-RAIL, or by visiting any staffed Amtrak station.

Amtrak accepts cash, MasterCard, Visa, American Express, Discover and debit cards with a credit card logo at all staffed ticket offices. Debit cards requiring a PIN are not accepted. Credit cards are also accepted at Quik-Trak™ kiosks and by Metrolink/Amtrak ticket vending machines.

### Amtrak eTickets

eTickets offer Amtrak passengers the convenience of skipping the ticket line and going straight to the gate by printing tickets anytime, anywhere or by using a smartphone to present the eTicket to the conductor. eTickets also can be printed at Amtrak ticket offices and Quik-Trak™ kiosks. Passengers purchasing group tickets will continue to receive paper value tickets.

### Amtrak Pacific Surfliner Holiday Service

On Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays, Train 761 operates as Train 1761 and operates 1-15 minutes later between Los Angeles and Chatsworth; on Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays, Train 544 operates as Train 744.

### COASTER Ticket Information

Passengers must have a valid ticket prior to boarding the train. Tickets may be purchased at Oceanside Transit Center Customer Service, or at vending machines located at each station with cash, credit or debit card.

### COASTER E-Ticketing

Avoid the lines on the platform by purchasing your COASTER tickets ahead of time! NCTD offers two easy ways to buy your COASTER tickets before you ride; online or with the NCTD mobile app. Use your credit or debit card and pay the same fare you would pay at a ticket vending machine. Store your payment information and your tickets – you can purchase up to two months in advance! It's the easiest way to beat the lines. Round trip, one way and special event tickets are now available for online and mobile purchasing. ### COASTER Holiday Service

COASTER operates on a holiday (Saturday) schedule on July 4, 2016, and a Sunday schedule on September 5, 2016.

- 100 series trains travel via the Ventura County Line.
- 200 series trains travel via the Antelope Valley Line.
- 600 series trains travel via the Orange County Line.
- 700 series trains travel via the 91/Perris Valley Line.
- 800 series trains travel via the Inland Empire-Orange County Line.
- 900 series trains travel via between L.A. Union Station and Burbank-Bob Hope Airport.

### Metrolink Ticket Information

Passengers must have a valid ticket prior to boarding the train. Tickets may be purchased at the vending machines located at each station with cash, debit card, Visa®, MasterCard®, American Express®, or Discover®, or at the ticket window at L.A. Union Station.

Now, Metrolink makes it just as quick and easy to purchase your train tickets by downloading Metrolink's ticketing app on your mobile device from the Google Play or App Store. After purchasing your ticket or pass, they will appear in your ticket wallet. You MUST activate your ticket or pass prior to boarding.

Use your Metrolink ticket to transfer to most connecting buses, shuttles, or rail lines for free. Metrolink tickets are valid on most connecting transit services at Metrolink Stations.

### Metrolink Holiday Service

## RAIL 2 RAIL® PROGRAM – Amtrak/Metrolink

The Rail 2 Rail® program allows Metrolink Monthly Pass holders along the Orange and Ventura County corridors to travel on Amtrak Pacific Surfliner trains within the station pairs of their pass at no additional charge, including Saturday and Sunday. Metrolink passengers simply show their Monthly Pass and board any Amtrak Pacific Surfliner train or bus to their destination. These additional trains are not available to holders of One-Way and Round-Trip tickets or 7-Day Passes. The Rail 2 Rail® program does NOT include travel on Coast Starlight trains.

All Metrolink ticket types are accepted on Amtrak trains between Burbank-Bob Hope Airport and Los Angeles Union Station.

Amtrak Pacific Surfliner Monthly Pass holders may ride any Metrolink train within the station pairs on their pass at no additional charge. Rail 2 Rail program not valid the week of Thanksgiving.



## NEW: Pacific Surfliner® Transit Transfer Program



The Pacific Surfliner Transit Transfer Program provides free connections to bus and transit services at most Pacific Surfliner stations. Simply show your Amtrak Pacific Surfliner paper ticket or e-Ticket when you board the connecting bus or shuttle. You can also purchase a discounted 1-day transit pass for Metro (Los Angeles) and MTS (San Diego) in the café car. ## RAIL 2 RAIL® PROGRAM – Amtrak/COASTER

All valid COASTER fare media will be accepted on board Pacific Surfliner trains 784, 790/1790, 796, 567, 573, and 595. These six select Pacific Surfliner trains operate every day and will stop at all eight COASTER stations. This special 'all stop' service is not available during Thanksgiving week. Amtrak tickets must be purchased for travel north of Oceanside.

## LOSSAN Rail Corridor Agency

The Los Angeles – San Diego – San Luis Obispo (LOSSAN) Rail Corridor Agency is a joint powers authority comprised of rail owners and operators along the 351-mile rail corridor between San Diego, Los Angeles, Orange County, Ventura, Santa Barbara, and San Luis Obispo. The LOSSAN Agency works collaboratively with member agencies to increase passenger rail ridership and revenue, and to enhance on-time performance, operational flexibility, and safety in the rail corridor for both passenger and freight services.

Effective July 1, 2015, the LOSSAN Agency assumed administrative responsibility for the Pacific Surfliner service, following the execution of an interagency transfer agreement with the State of California. Locally focused management will help to further enhance customer service, ensure efficient use of resources, and allow more effective decisions about train schedules, on-board amenities, and service expansion. The Pacific Surfliner is currently the second busiest Amtrak intercity route in the nation, with more than 2.8 million annual passengers. ## Bikes on Board

Bike reservations are required on the Pacific Surfliner. Bike reservations may be booked at Amtrak.com by clicking the "Add Bike to Trip" tab after selecting your departure and class of service. Passengers are required to properly secure bicycles on bike racks. Book early as reserved bike space is limited and may not be available on all trains or departures. Bikes are allowed without a reservation on all Metrolink and COASTER trains.

## Amtrak Thruway Bus Connections

Amtrak Thruway buses are convenient, dedicated motor coaches designed exclusively for Amtrak train passengers with connections to more than 175 additional destinations in California and Nevada that are not served by rail. For more information visit Amtrak.com.

## Amtrak Pacific Surfliner Del Mar Service
