The OC Bridges Program is partially funded by Measure M, Orange County's half-cent sales tax for transportation improvements.

As part of the OC Bridges Raymond Avenue undercrossing, a full closure of Raymond Avenue just south of Walnut Avenue near the BNSF railroad tracks in Fullerton will be required. The roadway closure will begin on or about Monday, July 17, 2017 and will remain closed for approximately 80 days. The closure is needed to allow crews to safely complete wall construction, relocate utilities and pave the roadway. During the closure, business and residential access will be maintained.

A detour route will be in place using Orangethorpe Avenue, Acacia Avenue and Commonwealth Avenue to reconnect with Raymond Avenue. Please refer to the back of this notice for the detour route during the closure. We apologize for any inconvenience this closure may cause.

Once complete, the bridge will separate vehicle traffic from train traffic by lowering the roadway beneath the railway crossing, enhancing safety and boosting mobility.

The City of Fullerton's and the Orange County Transportation Authority's highest priority is safety for its project workers and the public. Drivers, pedestrians and cyclists are asked to use caution when traveling through the project area. During construction, please:

- Slow down and watch for workers and equipment
- Allow extra time to get to work, school and appointments
- Be extra careful when driving at night and in rainy weather
- Avoid use of mobile phones or other distractions
- Watch for closures and follow detours
- Be patient. Remember that this is a short-term inconvenience for a long-term traffic solution.
