The OC Bridges Program is partially funded by Measure M, Orange County's half-cent sales tax for transportation improvements.

Construction of the Raymond Avenue undercrossing in Fullerton is progressing. Once complete, the bridge will separate vehicle traffic from train traffic by lowering the roadway beneath the railway crossing, enhancing safety and boosting mobility.

As part of the Raymond Avenue undercrossing project, temporary driveway and roadway closures will be required along Valencia Drive. These closures will allow crews to safely work on utilities, retaining walls and the Valencia Drive overcrossing and roadway reconstruction. These closures will begin on or about Saturday, October 1 and will be in place for approximately 9 months. During these closures, changes to business access along Raymond Avenue and Valencia Drive west of Sally Place have been carefully planned to minimize impacts. Business access will be maintained.

Please refer to the map on the back of this notice for the temporary business access points during this activity. Please use this notice to inform your employees, customers and delivery personnel in advance of these closures of the changes to access. We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause.

The City of Fullerton's and the Orange County Transportation Authority's highest priority is safety for its project workers and the public. Drivers, pedestrians and cyclists are asked to use caution when traveling through the area. During construction, please:

- Slow down and watch for workers and equipment
- Allow extra time to get to work, school and appointments
- Be extra careful when driving at night and in rainy weather
- Avoid use of mobile phones or other distractions
- Watch for closures and follow detours
- Be patient. Remember that this is a short-term inconvenience for a long-term traffic solution.
