The Orange County Transportation Authority has begun construction of the Placentia Avenue and Kraemer Boulevard undercrossings. In accordance with federal railroad safety regulations, residents should expect to hear an increase in the frequency of train horns because of construction activities on and around the railroad tracks, regardless of quiet zone designation.

**Regular work hours are Monday through Saturday, 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.**

The following construction activities are anticipated to begin during the next two weeks:

## Placentia Avenue

- Continue excavation and installing shoring for bridge construction
- Continue excavation and installing shoring for retaining wall construction
- Misc. demolition and removals, and install waterline improvements along Fender Avenue
- Connect temporary waterline to permanent waterline at Crowther Avenue / Placentia Avenue
- Remove abandoned/conflicting portion of waterline on Fender Avenue

## Kraemer Boulevard

- Continue installation of piling for retaining walls
- Continue placement of temporary shoring for bridge construction
- Complete storm drain structure south of Placentia Lakes
- Install sewer south of Placentia Lakes
- Begin installation of 60" storm drain structure at Kraemer Boulevard / Orangethorpe Avenue intersection
- Begin relocation of Anaheim waterline at Kraemer Boulevard / Orangethorpe Avenue intersection

## Orangethorpe Avenue

- Pre-construction utility relocations continue

## Tustin Avenue/Rose Drive

- Gas company relocations continue at Rose Drive and Orangethorpe Avenue intersection
- Demolition of "Currie Enterprises" building will begin. First phase will remove interior fixtures
- Removal of concrete pads and utility connections at OCTA-owned property behind fences at Del Cerro Mobile Estates

## Lakeview

- Right-of-way phase continues with property appraisals and evaluations
