

Construction Notification

May 4, 2012

The Orange County Transportation Authority has begun construction of the Placentia Avenue and Kraemer Boulevard undercrossings. In accordance with federal railroad safety regulations, residents should expect to hear an increase in the frequency of train horns because of construction activities on and around the railroad tracks, regardless of quiet zone designation.

Regular work hours are Monday through Saturday, 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.

The following construction activities are anticipated to begin during the next two weeks:

Placentia Avenue Undercrossing

- Contractor continuing soldier pile wall work within the BNSF corridor with drilling and setting beams on south side of BNSF ROW (some night-work required)
- Demolition / reconstruction for RCB Extension west of Placentia Ave. along south side of BNSF ROW
- Damp proofing north/south walls in anticipation of backfilling
- Survey, pothole and install sewer line south of BNSF tracks on Industrial Way and Crowther Ave.
- Survey, pothole and install waterline / storm drain on Crowther Ave. east of Placentia Ave.
- Installing soldier pile wall work within the BNSF corridor south side of BNSF ROW for 72-in RCP Storm **Drain Protection Structure**
- Grading and placing backfill / embankment / sub-ballast along temporary shoring wall at south side of BNSF tracks, west of Placentia
- Demolition work in by-pass road footprint place embankment and grade for by-pass road
- Be aware of potential lane reductions for work near Crowther/Placentia intersection

Kraemer Boulevard Undercrossing

- Property wall removal on SW corner will be completed
- Relocation of existing 78" storm drain to proceed and includes installation of utilities protection slab
- Grading for railroad shoofly (detour) along BNSF is ongoing
- Excavation and installation of temporary shoring for retaining wall #1 ongoing
- Bike detour signage
