The Orange County Transportation Authority is constructing the Placentia Avenue and Kraemer Boulevard undercrossings. Work is starting soon on the overcrossings at Orangethorpe Avenue and Tustin Avenue/Rose Drive. In accordance with federal railroad safety regulations, residents should expect to hear an increase in the frequency of train horns because of construction activities on and around the railroad tracks, regardless of quiet zone designation.

Regular work hours are Monday through Saturday, 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.

The following construction activities are anticipated to begin during the next two weeks:

Placentia Avenue

- Contractor completed bridge on June 11, 2013
- BNSF shift from shoofly to mainline track will start in June and be completed mid-July 2013
- Work will continue on Home Depot driveway

Kraemer Boulevard

- Contractor has completed bridge
- BNSF shift from shoofly to mainline track expected to start in June 2013
- Contractor will continue installing sanitary sewer and storm drain along Kraemer Boulevard north of bridge (night work)
- Contractor will continue constructing sanitary sewer at Orangethorpe Avenue intersection (night work)

Orangethorpe Avenue

- Contractor is expected to begin activities next week
- Tree removal along south Orangethorpe Avenue near Miller Place will begin soon
- Advanced utility relocation continues:
 - AT&T will pull cable and fiber in new section of backbone
 - SCE (Inland) is expected to complete underground next month

Tustin Avenue/Rose Drive

- Contractor is expected to begin work at the end of June
- Advanced utility relocations are continuing:
 - AT&T (Irish) relocations will continue within Del Cerro Mobile Estates
 - AT&T will continue to pull cable into new conduit backbone
 - SCE (Inland) will continue to relocate overhead line along south side of Orangethorpe Avenue to underground. Cabling to follow
 - Time Warner Cable (Source Broadband) is potholing existing services on Rose Drive
