

Construction Notification

November 21, 2014

The Orange County Transportation Authority is building a series of bridges to separate trains from vehicles along the BNSF corridor in Fullerton, Placentia and Anaheim. In accordance with federal railroad safety regulations, residents should expect to hear an increase in the frequency of train horns because of construction activities on and around the railroad tracks, regardless of quiet zone designation.

Regular work hours are Monday through Saturday, 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.

Lakeview Avenue Overcrossing Overcrossing

On Tuesday, November 25, the BNSF railroad gates are scheduled to be in the closed position from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. at Lakeview Avenue. Drivers traveling northbound on Lakeview Avenue will be directed to turn west on La Palma, north on Richfield and east on Orangethorpe. Drivers traveling southbound on Lakeview Avenue will be directed to turn west on Buena Vista, south on Richfield and east on Orangethorpe.

Police and fire personnel have been notified and will make the necessary accommodations. The gates will be returned to normal service as soon as the utility relocation work is completed.

Businesses on Lakeview Avenue between La Palma and the railroad tracks will remain open for business.
