## RAYMOND AVENUE 40-DAY FULL CLOSURE AND DETOUR

### STARTING APPROXIMATELY EARLY SEPTEMBER 2015

Construction is progressing on the Raymond Avenue undercrossing in Fullerton. Once complete, the bridge will separate vehicle traffic from train traffic by lowering the roadway beneath the railway crossing, enhancing safety and boosting mobility.

As part of the Raymond Avenue undercrossing, installation of a temporary north/south bypass road will require a 40-day full closure of Raymond Avenue from just south of Truslow Avenue to Valencia Drive in Fullerton. The approximate closure schedule is from **early September through mid-October 2015**. Periodically, work activities may extend beyond typical 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. work hours. Please watch for posted changeable message signs for the latest information about the closure period.

Please refer to the map on the back of this notice for the recommended detour routes during this closure. **Residential and business access will be maintained.**

As a reminder, a full closure at Valencia Drive just east of Raymond Avenue began in May 2015 and will be in place for approximately 18 months. We apologize for any inconvenience these activities may cause.

The City of Fullerton's and the Orange County Transportation Authority's highest priority is safety for its project workers and the public. Drivers, pedestrians and cyclists are asked to use caution when traveling through the area. During construction, please:

- Slow down and watch for workers and equipment
- Allow extra time to get to work, school and appointments
- Be extra careful when driving at night and in rainy weather
- Avoid use of mobile phones or other distractions
- Watch for closures and follow detours
- Be patient. Remember that this is a short-term inconvenience for a long-term traffic solution.

*Please note full closures at State College Boulevard at the BNSF Railway through spring 2018 and Valencia Drive east of Raymond Avenue through early 2017. To avoid delays, please plan your commute.*
