The OC Bridges Program is partially funded by Measure M. Orange County's half-cent sales tax for transportation improvements.

The City of Fullerton and the Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA) have partnered to construct the Raymond Avenue undercrossing. Once complete, the bridge will separate vehicle traffic from train traffic by lowering the roadway beneath the railroad crossing, enhancing safety and boosting mobility.

Construction of the bridge will require a temporary closure of the north side of Acacia Avenue at E. Valencia Drive near the BNSF Railway in Fullerton. This closure is scheduled to begin on or around February 25, 2015 and is expected to remain in place through late March.


A designated detour route will be in place using Orangethorpe Avenue, Raymond Avenue and Commonwealth Avenue to reconnect with Acacia Avenue. Please refer to the map on the back of this notice for the detour route during this closure. Residential and business access will be maintained. We apologize for any inconvenience this activity may cause.

Drivers and pedestrians are asked to use caution when traveling through the area. The Orange County Transportation Authority's highest priority is safety for its project workers and the public. During construction, please:

- Slow down and watch for workers and equipment
- Allow extra time to get to work, school and appointments
- Be extra careful when driving at night and in rainy weather
- Avoid use of mobile phones or other distractions
- Watch for closures and follow detours.
- Be patient. Remember that this is a short-term inconvenience for a long-term traffic solution.
