Placentia Metrolink Station



The newest train station planned in Orange County is the Placentia station. The station will be conveniently located at Melrose Avenue and Crowther Avenue near the Orange Freeway (SR-57), serving the communities of Anaheim, Fullerton, Placentia and Yorba Linda. The Placentia station will be Orange County's 12th train station and will serve Metrolink's 91 Line that extends to Riverside, Fullerton and downtown Los Angeles.

Timeline

The station's environmental impact report was approved in May 2007, and the project is currently in the final design phase which will be completed late 2010. Currently, funding has been allocated for construction to begin during fiscal year 2012 / 2013. The city of Placentia and OCTA are working together to ensure the timely implementation of this project.

Metrolink

Orange County Metrolink service began in 1994 with nearly 144,000 riders. Over the past 14 years, Metrolink has increased roundtrip routes, added new stations and established three rail lines that serve more than 4 million passengers per year.

Metrolink's 91 Line has recently experienced a dramatic increase in ridership in Orange County over the past five years. Currently nine daily Metrolink trains run along the 91 Line and once the Placentia station is completed, 13 Metrolink trains are expected to serve the line.

Future Placentia station highlights:

- Located in the heart of Placentia, adjacent to neighborhoods, businesses and Cal State Fullerton
- Provide Metrolink service (91 Line)
- Public restrooms
- Comfortable waiting area equipped with benches and shaded structures
- Pedestrian accessibility
- Information kiosk and automated ticket vending machines
- Enhance security features
- 500-space parking facility
- Transit accessibility

Metrolink Service Expansion Program

In 2005, OCTA's board of directors approved the Metrolink Service Expansion Program (MSEP) to provide more frequent train service between Fullerton and Laguna Niguel / Mission Viejo. Increased weekday service will launch in early 2010.

The \$382.5 million Metrolink Service Expansion Program is funded by Measure M, Orange County's half-cent sales transportation tax.

Background

Metrolink is Southern California's rail system linking residential communities to employment and activity centers. Metrolink is operated by the Southern California Regional Rail Authority (SCRRA)—a joint powers authority of five member agencies representing the counties of Los Angeles, Orange, Riverside, San Bernardino and Ventura. As one of five member agencies, OCTA administers all of Orange County's Metrolink rail corridor service.
