

A Brief Overview



- 30-year ½ cent sales tax
- Approved by the Voters in November 2006
- Project V Included in the ordinance
- First Call approved June 2013
 - \$9.8 million awarded for Five Projects
- Eligible Applicants
 - Orange County Local Agencies
 - No Private Entities



Funds Available for 2016 Call



Measure M funds \$20 million



Matching Requirements



- Capital Match minimum 10 %
- Operations and Maintenance
 - Measure M contribution not to increase \$9 per boarding or 90% whichever is less
- Planning Projects Match minimum 10%







Funding Caps



Measure M funds

Per Project, Per Year – up to \$550,000

- Capital Costs Up to \$550,000 annually
- Operating Reserve Up to \$550,000 annually
- Marketing \$25,000 startup and up to \$10,000 annually for the remaining grant period

Planning – Up to \$50,000 per agency



Eligible Capital Expenses



- Bus and Vehicle Purchase and Leases
- Bike Racks
- Software
- Communication Equipment
- Fare Collection
- Bus Stop Improvements for new eligible service only
- Maintenance Facilities and fueling stations required for new service

Eligible Operations Expenses



- Operations cost related to the new or expanded eligible service
 - Fixed Route
 - Deviated fixed Route
 - Demand Responsive
 - Seasonal community shuttles
 - Other flexible and innovative service
- Parking Leases needed for new eligible service
- Marketing Efforts limited to funding caps

Ineligible Expenses



- Right-of-Way Acquisition
- Fare Subsidies
- Supplanting Existing Transit Services

Reporting Requirements



- Ridership Reports due Quarterly
 - > To ensure cost effectiveness
- Customer Satisfaction Annually
 - > To ensure quality of service
- On Time Performance Annually
 - > To ensure reliability
- NTD Reporting
 - > Reporting to the FTA

Expenditure Requirements



Obligate Funds within the Fiscal Year of Programming

- Purchase/Lease Vehicles
- Start Service / Contract Award

Delay Policy

Subject to OCTA Board Approval

Expend funds within 36 months from the obligation date

Extension Requests – Subject to OCTA Board Approval
