
## M2 Freeway Program



### M2 Transit Program




- Continued Metrolink service as well as station, track and grade crossing safety improvements

#### **Environmental Cleanup Program (ECP)**


- Over \$57.2 million allocated for 219 water quality projects
  - √ 60 million gallons of trash captured


#### Freeway Environmental Mitigation Program (EMP)
