# KEEPING RANGE COUNTY MOVING

## **GOAL: PURSUE FUNDING FOR ORANGE COUNTY**

- \$218 million Trade Corridor Improvement Fund
- \$4 million traffic signal funds
- \$2.7 million federal appropriation
- \$1 million Homeland Security grant



# KEEPING RANGE COUNTY MOVING

## **GOAL: ADVANCE BUS RAPID TRANSIT (BRT)**

- Finalized branding package
- Received first BRT vehicle
- Coordinated with corridor cities
- Initiated design of technology elements



# KEEPING 🍊 RANGE COUNTY MOVING

## GOAL: INCREASE YOUTH MARKETING

- Conducted 65 presentations
- Expanded summer youth marketing
- Launched “Road Trip to Learning” curriculum





# KEEPING 🍊 RANGECOUNTY MOVING

## GOAL: EXPAND RAIL SERVICES

- Completed design and bid expansion projects
  - Includes grade crossings & quiet zones
- Initiated Orange pedestrian crossing construction
- Opened Irvine parking structure
- Metrolink ridership up 15%

## GOAL: IMPROVE INTERCOUNTY CONNECTIONS

- Collaborated with Riverside on toll road extension
- Completed OC/LA border study
- Strategized with San Diego on rail service integration

## **GOAL: ASSESS PACIFIC ELECTRIC RIGHT OF WAY (PE ROW)**

- Elevated awareness of corridor challenges
- Conducted tours, virtual tours
- Studied under OC/LA border study

## GOAL: REVIEW ORANGE FREEWAY EXTENSION


- Launched Central County Corridor Major Investment Study
