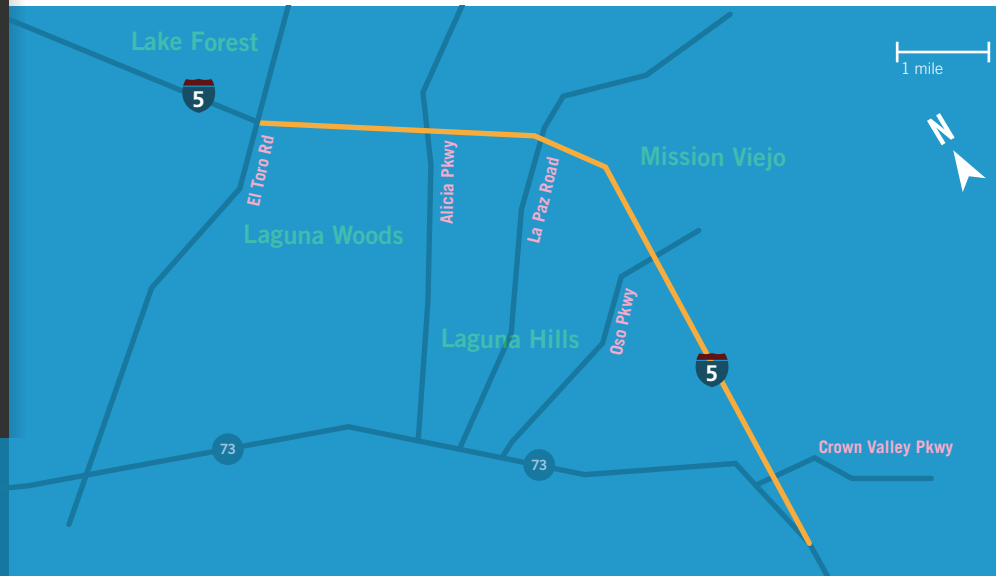

PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

The \$560 million project will:

- Widen the I-5 to accommodate additional general purpose lanes in each direction
- Reestablish existing auxiliary lanes
- Extend the second carpool lane from El Toro Road to Alicia Parkway in both directions
- Modify ramps as needed
- Reconstruct Avery Parkway and La Paz Road interchanges

PROJECT STUDY REPORTS

The PSR was approved by Caltrans in March 2011. The project report and environmental documents (PA/ED) from El Toro Road to the SR-73, include three alternatives:

- No build
- Add one general purpose lane in each direction, extend the second carpool lane in both directions, and reconstruct La Paz Road and Avery Parkway interchanges; or
- Same as above, but add two general purpose lanes in each direction
