



MORE METROLINK IS COMING TO ORANGE COUNTY

EXPANDED WEEKDAY SERVICE

WHEN: Effective July 5, 2011

WHERE: Expanded service runs between the Fullerton and Laguna Niguel/Mission Viejo stations.

ADDED TRAINS: Six trains will be added to the new expanded weekday schedule providing additional service later in the afternoon and evenings.

EXPANDED WEEKEND SERVICE

WHEN: Additional weekend trips will run from July 2 through October 9, 2011.

WHERE: Expanded weekend service will be added on the Orange County Line (Los Angeles-Oceanside) and the Inland Empire-Orange County Line (San Bernardino-Oceanside).

ADDED TRAINS: Four additional trips are scheduled along the Orange County Line and one new seasonal trip to Oceanside will be added to the Inland Empire-Orange County Line.

NEW PASS: New All-Weekend Pass costs \$10 and is valid systemwide from 7 pm Friday until midnight on Sunday.

PURCHASE: All-Weekend Passes can only be purchased at Metrolink Ticket Vending Machines located at all Metrolink stations. The fare will continue after October 9th.

OCLINK | ALL-DAY RAIL/BUS PASS

BY RAIL: OCLINK Pass gives you all-day weekday access anywhere in Orange County on the Orange County Line and the Inland Empire-Orange County Line.

BY BUS: The OCLINK Pass gives you all-day weekday access on any local OCTA bus. This pass is not valid on ACCESS and express bus service.

COST: The new OCLINK Pass costs \$7; \$6 for seniors and persons with disabilities. Passes purchased in advance are marked PREPAID.

OCLINK PASSES can be purchased:

1. Online
2. On all OCTA buses
3. At Ralphs and Vons Supermarkets
4. OCTA Store in Orange
5. Metrolink Ticket Vending Machines at all Orange County stations
6. By calling 714-560-5932.

Please note: If you purchased your OCLINK Pass online, at the OCTA Store, via phone or at Ralphs or Vons Supermarkets, you must validate your ticket at a validator machine, located at all Metrolink stations, before boarding the train.
