



RIVERSIDE FREEWAY SR-91 Improvement Project

The Riverside Freeway (SR-91) serves as a major commuting route connecting Orange County with Riverside and Los Angeles counties. SR-91 is also one of the most congested freeways in Southern California.

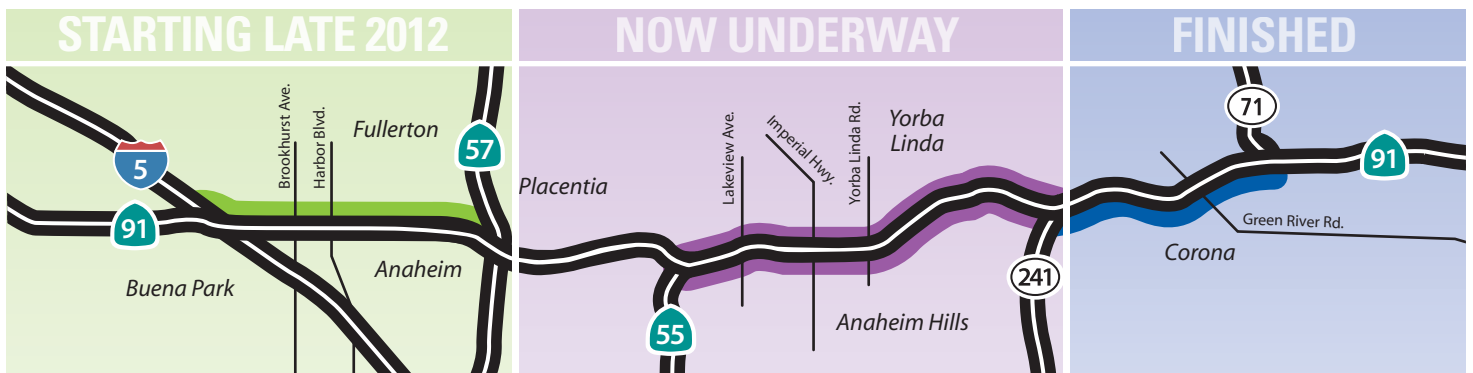
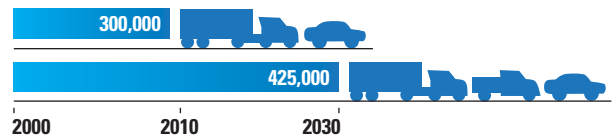
To improve traffic flow along SR-91 between the Santa Ana Freeway (I-5) in Buena Park and the Corona Freeway (SR-71) in Corona, the Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA), Caltrans District 12 and the Riverside County Transportation Commission (RCTC) are working together to add new lanes to SR-91.

Overall Benefits:

- Add new lanes to increase capacity at key points between I-5 and SR-71
- Improve flow of traffic on SR-91 throughout this 22-mile stretch
- Improve driving operations and enhance safety
