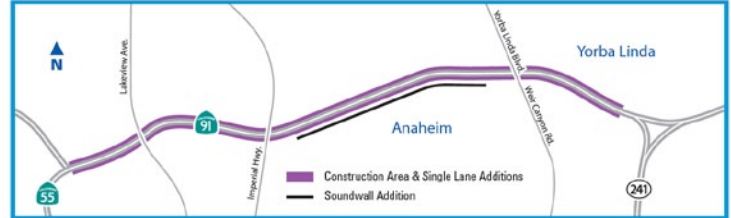




SR-91 WESTBOUND AND EASTBOUND LANE WIDENING PROJECT

Project Description

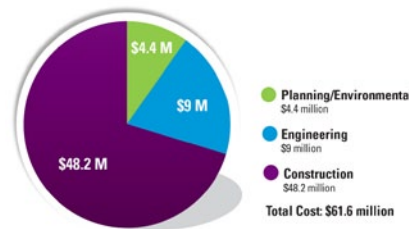
Continuing on the promise to improve mobility on SR-91, the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) and the Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA) will add a new six-mile lane in each direction between SR-241 and SR-55 – delivering a better drive through Anaheim and Yorba Linda and “A Better 91” for our community. This project will increase capacity, improve operations and relieve congestion on the freeway for the thousands who drive it every day.



Project Benefits

The new SR-91 Eastbound Lane Addition Project will:

- ✓ One new six-mile lane in the westbound and eastbound directions between SR-241 and SR-55
- ✓ Standardized 12-foot lanes and 10-foot right shoulders
- ✓ Widen bridges at Weir Canyon Rd./Yorba Linda Blvd. and Imperial Hwy.
- ✓ New striping throughout project limits
- ✓ Soundwall on eastbound side of the freeway along key residential area



Soundwall

Estimated for completion in Spring 2012, the new SR-91 concrete soundwall will extend from Imperial Hwy. to Weir Canyon Rd. and rise approximately 16 feet high at any given point.

Funding Sources

Funding for the \$61.6 million project comes from a variety of sources that include the State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP), Corridor Mobility Improvement Account (CMIA), and Measure M, the Orange County voter approved half-cent local transportation sales tax.

Putting People to Work

Expected to create 918 jobs for construction workers, engineers, safety personnel, materials providers and more, this project supports Caltrans’ and OCTA’s commitment to invest in our economy by delivering projects that improve mobility and efficiency benefiting residents, employers and the goods movement industry.

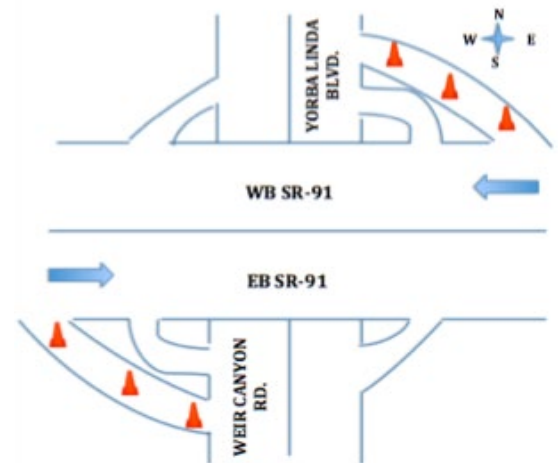
YORBA LINDA BLVD./WEIR CANYON RD. RAMP WORK OCTOBER 10, 2011 – FEBRUARY 2012

ABOUT THE RAMP WORK:

Starting Monday, October 10 at 10 p.m., construction crews will temporarily reduce lanes on the Yorba Linda Blvd./Weir Canyon Rd. off-ramps on eastbound and westbound SR-91.

During this time, the off-ramps will remain open to traffic but commuters are strongly encouraged to plan commutes and anticipate back-up. This work will create a safe work space as crews make room for the freeway widening. The new ramp alignment will remain in place through approximately February 2012.

Caltrans and OCTA remind motorists to please plan ahead, reduce speeds and leave enough braking distance to the vehicle in front of you. Please always use caution while traveling in a construction zone and remember to Slow for the Cone Zone.
