- After your application is reviewed and all information is verified, you will receive an Eligibility Approval Form and a list indicating the locations of the OCTA-approved photography centers. There is a \$2.00 fee which must be paid to the photography center. The photographer will take two ID photographs and will mail them to OCTA for final processing. OCTA will mail your identification card to you in about ten days.

Should an application for the Senior Citizen Identification Card be denied, the applicant must submit a written appeal within 14 days of denial letter date, requesting a review and reconsideration of the application.
