Tustin Avenue/Rose Drive Overcrossing Project



OC BRIDGES Improving safety. Removing delays.

The Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA) will construct a vehicle overpass at the intersection of Tustin Avenue / Rose Drive (Tustin/Rose) and Orangethorpe Avenue, along the Burlington Northern Santa Fe railroad track. Approximately 2,100 feet of Tustin/Rose will be elevated and realigned to pass over Orangethorpe Avenue and the railroad tracks.

Orangethorpe will be widened and restriped to accommodate turning lanes needed to connect to the access road, which will rise to meet the elevated Tustin/Rose roadway. The intersection will remain open (with very limited closures) using a detour road during a substantial period of the construction phase. When completed, the project will allow cars to safely cross over the railroad tracks, and train horns will no longer be needed at this rail crossing

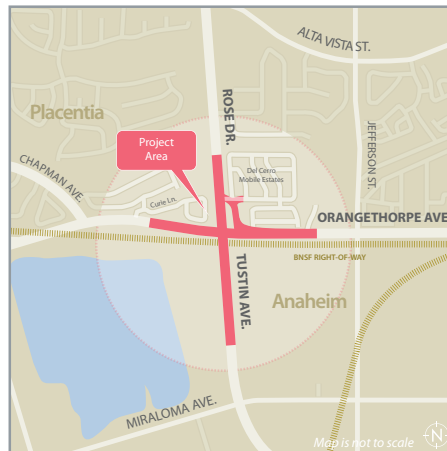
Construction Schedule

Construction of the Tustin Avenue/Rose Drive overcrossing is expected to start in 2012 and be completed by the end of 2014. Work is scheduled so that adjacent crossings are not closed to drivers at the same time, and OCTA is working to reduce the effects of construction on the community. Some night work is anticipated throughout the project.

Safety: OCTA's Top Priority

OCTA's highest priority is job safety. During construction, please:

- Slow down and watch for workers and equipment
- Allow extra time to get to work, school and appointments
- Be extra careful when driving at night and in rainy weather
- Avoid use of mobile phones or other distractions
- Watch for closures and follow detours
- Be patient. Remember that this is a short-term inconvenience for a long-term benefit.



Project Funding

Total project cost: \$103 million

- Federal - \$60.2 million
- State - \$31.4 million
- Measure M2 - \$11.4 million

What to Expect During Construction

During construction, the Orange County Transportation Authority will work to reduce the impact of construction to the area. Please expect the following:

- **Changes to Travel Patterns** – The intersection with Orangethorpe Avenue and Tustin/Rose will remain open with limited closures using a new detour road. Please follow the detour road and watch for changing conditions.
- **Dust** – Construction projects cause dust. Watering trucks will help reduce dust.
- **Noise** - Heavy equipment will be used periodically, creating noise.
- **Notices** - If you live or work nearby, you will receive notices about construction work. Please watch for printed notices and signs, and register to receive email and Twitter updates.

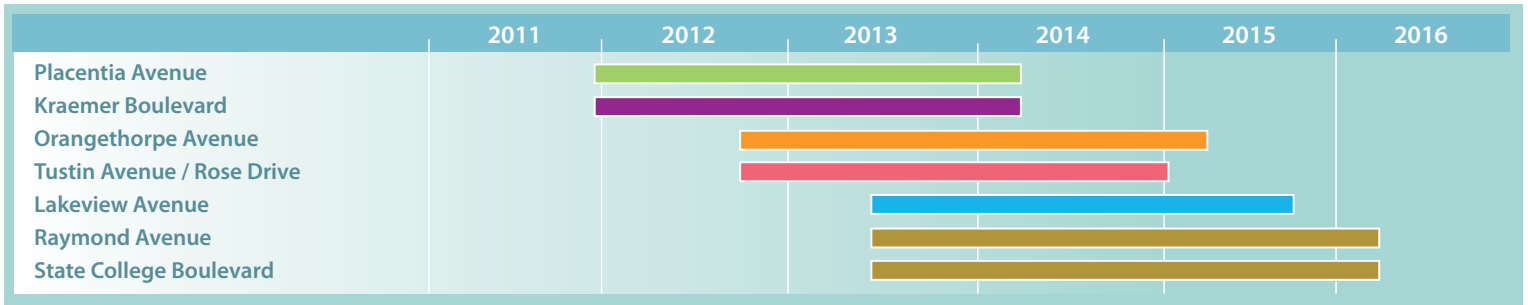
