## **New Issue: Proposition 1B**

- OCTA requests \$662 million of Proposition 1B funds for:
  - I-405/I-605/SR-22 Interchange
  - Improvements on SR-91, SR-57 and I-5 corridors
- Caltrans recommends \$405 million for the I-405/I-605/SR-22 Interchange and SR-91
- California Transportation Commission makes funding decisions at February 28 meeting in Orange County – \$4.5 billion available for nearly \$18 billion in requests



#### **New Issue: SR-91 Corridor**

- Riverside County Transportation Commission (RCTC) plans to expand SR-91 by adding general-purpose lanes and extending the 91 Express lanes
  - Need to revisit coordination of plans at county boundary
  - Requires common toll road operational policies
  - Legislative and financial implications: duration of franchise, use of excess revenues and governance
  - Presentation by RCTC and discussion at Feb. 2
    SR-91 Advisory Committee

#### **New Issue: Goods Movement**

- Accommodating increased freight traffic from ports
  - Demands for increased passenger and goods movement capacity on east-west corridors
  - Mitigation of impacts on local communities is major Orange County concern
  - Prop 1B funds potentially available
  - Board Workshop on January 22



#### **New Issue: Procurement**

- Issues reviewed in 2006:
  - Board approval of Requests for Proposal (RFP) prior to release
  - Post draft RFP's on Internet
  - Standardized evaluation criteria/weighting
  - Debarred/disqualified list
  - Equal weighting for prior work regardless of client
- Board workshop in March 2007
- Adopt revised procurement policies
