Background

- April 2005: Board approved agreement to replace OCTA's aging fleet of personal computers
- March 2005: F&A Committee gave direction to investigate transferring surplus equipment to OC schools

Background

- Orange County Department of Education (OCDE) response was overwhelmingly enthusiastic
- 28 Orange County school districts
- Alternatives were to auction, donate to charity, sell as scrap, or dispose
- OCTA Legal Counsel and Procurement Department endorsed the transfer program

Benefits

- Useful purpose for equipment in a public agency with need
- Computers were better than existing, or the first acquired
- Avoid disposal costs

Progress To Date

- 10 transfers since October 2005
- 400+ personal computers
- OCTA removes hard drives for security reasons prior to transfer
- OCDE outfits computers with new hard drives and distributes to schools
