Before Improvement



The Situation Today

The Beach Boulevard/Garden Grove Freeway (SR-22) Interchange was built as a cloverleaf that requires drivers to merge across traffic in order to access the on- and off-ramps. Several improvements are planned to eliminate the need for cross-traffic weaving and to create a safer, more efficient traffic flow.

After Improvement



Improvements Planned

1. Two off-ramps will be removed: the eastbound off-ramp heading north on Beach Boulevard and the westbound off-ramp heading south on Beach Boulevard. The new re-configured off-ramps will provide access to northbound and southbound Beach Boulevard.
2. The remaining ramps will be widened and re-aligned to improve traffic flow.
3. Traffic signals will be installed at off-ramps to Beach Boulevard.
4. A high occupancy vehicle (HOV) or carpool lane will be added in each direction between SR-55 and Valley View Street.
5. A new auxiliary lane will be added in each direction between The City Drive and Beach Boulevard.
