Widened Bridges

The three lanes of traffic in both directions will be shifted toward the center, leaving more room on the outside near the shoulder for the new bridge section to be constructed.

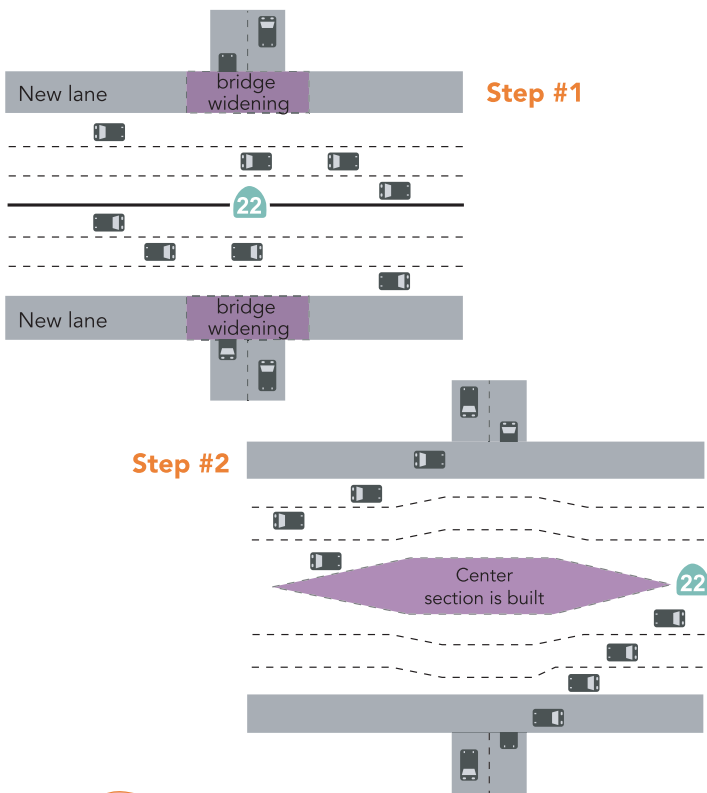
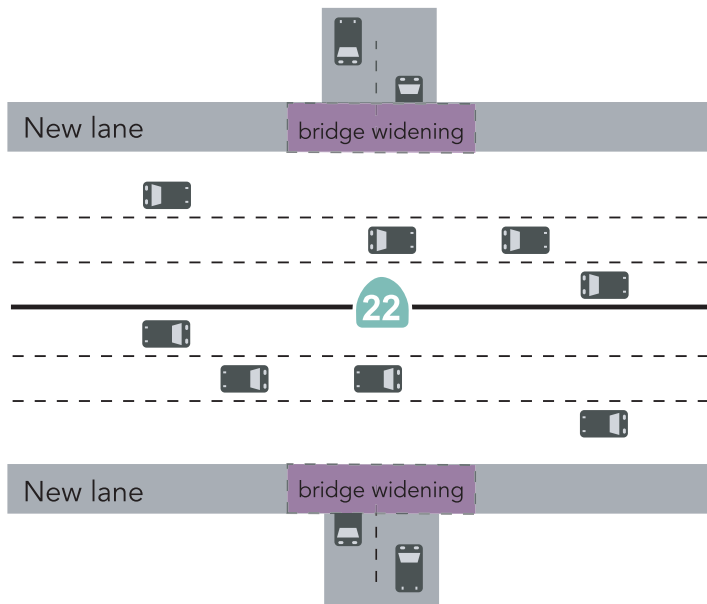

Replaced Bridges

The three lanes of traffic in both directions move toward the center as outside portions of existing bridges are removed and rebuilt. Once the outsides are complete, traffic will be shifted to the newly-built sections, and the existing bridge in the middle will be taken down and replaced by a new center bridge section that ties into the previously constructed outside sections.

Bridges to be replaced:

- Brookhurst Street
- Euclid Street
- Harbor Blvd
- Pearce Street Pedestrian Bridge
- Lewis Street
