

Construction Alert: Night Work Activities

March 9, 2012

Placentia Avenue Undercrossing

The Orange County Transportation Authority has begun construction of the Placentia Avenue undercrossing. Although regular work hours are Monday through Saturday, 7 a.m. to 8 p.m., there are limited times when night work will be necessary.

Night work is required to allow crews to drill holes to set beams for the soldier pile wall from State Route 57 to approximately 500 feet east of the freeway. The equipment is restricted and low impact lighting will be used.

Night work will be performed south of the property wall along the railroad corridor from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.

Day time work (setting beams in concrete) will be performed north of the property wall from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.

This work will begin **Sunday night, March 18, 2012**. Working Sunday through Thursday night for up to 20 nights is allowed by permit with the City of Placentia. Please note that all scheduled construction activities are subject to change due to weather conditions or other unanticipated events.
