










Ortega Highway Bridge Reconstruction

Proposed Longer-Term Closures

- Northbound I-5 off-ramp at Ortega Highway (3 weeks)
- Southbound I-5 on-ramp at Ortega Highway (6 weeks)
- Ortega Highway between southbound I-5 ramps and Del Obispo Street (3 weeks)
- Ortega Highway between Del Obispo Street and El Camino Real (4 weeks)
