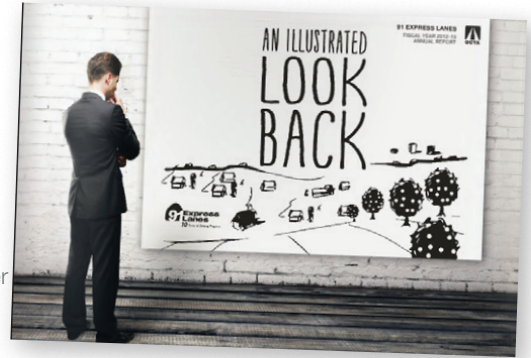
Enjoy the Journey of the 91 Express Lanes

Many elements come together to create the fast, safe, reliable commute millions enjoy each year on the 91 Express Lanes. To find out more about the history of this renowned toll road and learn about OCTA's ongoing efforts to keep it operating smoothly for you, check out the annual report for fiscal year 2012-2013 online at www.octa.net/91expresslanes.

Ten years ago, OCTA purchased the 91 Express Lanes on behalf of those who use the State Route 91 Corridor. To commemorate that anniversary, this year the theme of the report is "An Illustrated Look Back." Please enjoy the accompanying video and watch as the history of the 91 Express Lanes takes shape through the pen strokes of a talented sketch artist.

The annual report highlights last year's progress in keeping the 91 Express Lanes a free-flowing, stress-free commute. Last year, OCTA finalized a third-party agreement that will streamline

inter-county travel as the express lanes extend into Riverside County so travelers can experience another eight miles of traffic relief. In addition, OCTA installed violation enforcement lights to deter unlawful motorists from entering the 91 Express Lanes.

Travel on the 91 Express Lanes Requires a FasTrak™ Transponder



As you know, your vehicle must be equipped with a FasTrak transponder linked to a pre-paid account to use the 91 Express Lanes.

That's not the case with other toll roads within Orange County; some use different systems to collect payment in addition to FasTrak. On the Foothill (State Route 241), the San Joaquin

Hills (State Route 73), and the Eastern (State Routes 241, 133 and 261) transportation corridors, the recently introduced ExpressAccounts and One-Time-Toll accounts read license plate numbers and offer various options for payment settlement. A transponder is not required. Toll rates with FasTrak accounts are 45 cents to \$1.10 lower than these other types of accounts.

This system of toll roads is completely separate from the 91 Express Lanes and the ExpressAccounts and One-Time-Toll systems do not apply to it.

So keep your transponder handy when traveling on the 91 Express Lanes. You'll save an average of 30 minutes per trip while traveling in free-flowing lanes for 10 miles without stopping to pay tolls.

April 2014 Toll Schedule

There were no toll adjustments for the quarter starting April 1, 2014. If you have a toll card dated July 1, 2013, you can continue to use it.
