OCTA Turns 25

This year marks the 25th anniversary of the formation of the Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA). In 1991, OCTA was created by the consolidation of seven separate transportation planning agencies, including OCTA's predecessor agency, the Orange County Transit District, which was established in 1972.

Among its many accomplishments during a quarter century of transportation improvements was the purchase in 2003 of the privately held 91 Express Lanes. OCTA's purchase removed restrictions and opened the way to improvements that benefit all motorists along the SR-91 corridor. Over the years, OCTA has invested more than \$22.9 million in toll revenue for general-purpose lane projects on SR-91, making the trip between Orange and Riverside counties better for all.



Improvements Prompt Weekend Closures

To continue delivering a smooth, safe journey at free-flowing speed, OCTA and Caltrans are repaving the entire 91 Express Lanes from the SR-55 freeway in Anaheim to the Orange County/Riverside County line. As the pavement rehabilitation project unfolds along the 42 miles that make up the four-lane, 10-mile 91 Express Lanes, it will use 113,000 tons of asphalt and grind and replace 375,000 square yards of pavement.

The project will also replace six changeable messaging signs.

During the project, the 91 Express Lanes and sections of the SR-91 #1 general-purpose lane are scheduled for closure on consecutive weekends. Consider taking Metrolink, vanpooling, or ridesharing. Is Your Transponder Beeping?

As we prepare to extend the 91 Express Lanes into Riverside County, toll equipment is being installed east of the existing 91 Express Lanes. Your transponder may beep as you drive under the new toll equipment.

Despite the beep, you are not being charged for any additional tolls. Prior to the opening of the new extended Express Lanes, you will receive detailed information about how to use the new extension and any applicable tolls pertaining to them.

The State Route 91 Improvement Project (91 Project) will extend the 91 Express Lanes eight miles eastward from the Orange/Riverside county line to the I-15 interchange. The Riverside County Transportation Commission (RCTC) is managing the construction. OCTA and RCTC will jointly administer the toll lanes to provide customers with a consistent journey along the entire length.

Travel Other Roads with Your FasTrak® Transponder

That FasTrak® transponder that provides safe, reliable, predictable travel on the 91 Express Lanes can be used on other roadways as well.

Use your FasTrak® transponder anywhere you see the FasTrak® name or symbol. In addition to the 91 Express Lanes, toll facilities currently using the FasTrak® system include the Foothill (SR-241), the San Joaquin Hills (SR 73), and the Eastern (SR-241, 133 and 261) Transportation Corridors; all are located in Orange County. In Los Angeles County, you can use FasTrak® on the I-110 and I-10 Metro ExpressLanes.

FasTrak® is also accepted on the SR-125 and I-15 Express Lanes in San Diego, and the Carquinez, Benicia-Martinez, Richmond-San Rafael, San Francisco-Oakland Bay and Golden Gate bridges in the San Francisco Bay area. The tolls will be billed to your pre-paid account.

Discounted tolls and special offers are limited to travel on the 91 Express Lanes only. All 91 Express Lanes customers will be charged the full toll amount for travel on all other FasTrak® toll facilities.
