


Regional Traffic Signal Synchronization Program

- Regional projects that cross multiple jurisdictions
- Goal to regularly coordinate signals on a 750-mile network
- Competitive funding for local agencies
- Three-year grants for signal timing
- Local agencies implement or lead projects
 - o OCTA optional implement or lead projects
- Local agencies contribute 20 percent match in funding

Summary of Results for Completed Projects


• 38 signal synchronization projects completed

• \$24.1 million improvements along 436 miles of roadway

• 1,682 signalized intersections

Summary of Results for Completed Projects

- Travel times improved an average of 13 percent
- Average safe speeds improved an average of 15 percent
- Stops-per-mile improved an average of 31 percent



Travel Time Improvement Average Speed Improvement Stops Per Mile Improvement

Summary of Results for Completed Projects



Reduction of over 573.1 million pounds in greenhouse gases



Saved fuel consumption by 23.8 million gallons



At \$3.90 per gallon of gas, projects will save the public \$109.5 million



At \$2.90 per gallon of gas, projects will save the public \$81.5 million

- 49 signal projects in-progress involving 35 agencies
- \$56.8 million of improvements
- 347 miles and 1,326 signals
