



# OCTA M2 Environmental Mitigation Program Update April 21, 2015 CAC Meeting

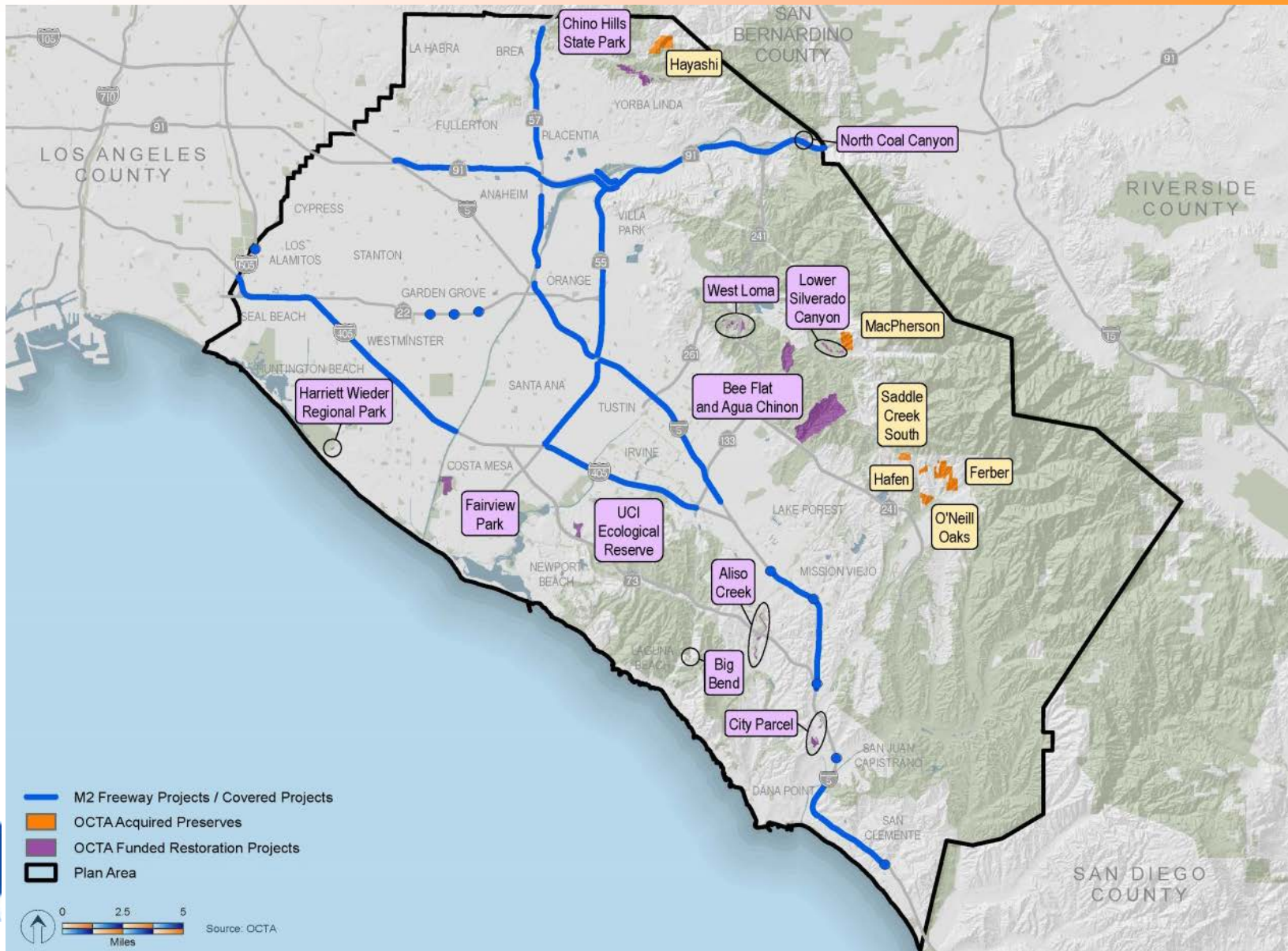


- Measure M2 includes a provision to provide comprehensive mitigation for freeway projects
  - 5% of freeway revenues dedicated to comprehensive mitigation
  - Satisfies State & Federal Wildlife Agencies' Permitting Processes
  - Satisfies Other Mitigation Needs (e.g., State & Federal Clean Water Act permits)



- Acquired six properties
- Funded 11 habitat restoration projects
- Natural Community Conservation Plan/Habitat Conservation Plan (NCCCP/HCP)
  - Public review between November 2014 and February 2015
  - Public meetings in November and December 2014





- Monitoring required on the Preserves and Restoration projects
- Establish framework for endowment to fund long-term management
  - Revenue stream to pay for long-term land management of Preserves
  - Begin funding endowment in 2016/17
- Resource Management Plans (RMPs) outline specific Preserve needs (available summer 2015)
