BACKGROUND

The San Juan Capistrano train station opened in 1894. The station closed in 1966 and railroad service to the town ended, but it reopened in 1974 after Amtrak reinstated service. The station is in historic downtown near Camino Capistrano and Verdugo Street, a short walk from Mission San Juan Capistrano.

STATION HIGHLIGHTS

PARKING

- 108 commuter parking spaces
- Parking structure at 26732 Verdugo Street
- Spaces 1 to 34 (Basement Level) overnight parking only (metered). 7 days a week and 72-hour parking limit.
- Spaces 35 to 108 (Basement Level) all-day public parking (metered). 7 days a week. No overnight parking 2:00 a.m. to 5:00 a.m. Commuter parking permits exempt from meter payment.
- Space 109 to 255 (Levels 1, 2, 3) public parking (metered). 7 days a week. No overnight parking 2:00 a.m. to 5:00 a.m. Franciscan Plaza Employee Parking Permit exempt from meter payment.
- Space 1 to 34 (Basement Level): \$20 a day - pay first by space number at pay station.
- Space 35 to 108 (Basement Level): \$2 hourly parking or \$12 all-day parking \$2 all-day parking if parked before 10:00 a.m. Pay first by space number at pay station.
- Space 109 to 255 (Levels 1, 2, 3): \$2 hourly parking. Pay first by space number at pay station.

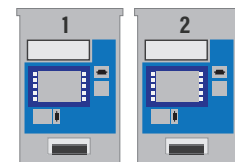
