BACKGROUND

The Tustin train station, built in 2002, is located near the corner of Edinger Avenue and Jamboree Road (State Route 261). It is just east of the former Marine Corps Air Station Tustin, whose hangars, built during World War II, inspired the train station's architecture.

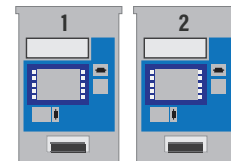
