The Need for Changes to GRH Program

- Budget \$\$\$
- Regional Program
 Sponsored by MTA, OCTA, RCTC and SANBAG
- No Cost to Enroll
 - Same as previous program

Program Change Highlights

Current GRH Program

- No out-of-pocket cost
- Call center will help dispatch service provider
- Authorization form needed, including approval number *before* trip
- 4 rides per 12-month period

NEW GRH Program

- Trip cost is reimbursed
- Employer/employee arranges trip with service provider
- Authorization form needed, including supporting documentation *after* trip
- 2 rides per 12-month period

Transitioning to the New GRH Program

- Effective March 1, 2012
- Existing clients automatically enrolled
- Updated materials available mid-February:
 GRH Employer Handbook
 GRH Policies & Procedures
 - GRH Reimbursement Request Forms

Rule 2202 - ECRP Plan Compliance

Option One

Provide the program as previously provided by:

- Arranging for the ride
- Paying for the ride

Amend your ECRP plan to replace the GRH strategy.

- Cost \$151.23
- New strategy must be as (or more) effective as GRH

Option Two

A Seamless Transition Plan

- Establish a budget to pay for the ride
- If necessary, establish agreements with rental car and taxi providers
- Have transit schedules on hand
- Assign a GRH contact person at your worksite and provide updates to your employees

Options for GRH Reimbursement

- Employer must submit reimbursement
- Employee or Employer can be designated to receive the reimbursement
- Reimbursement for Employer provided trips <u>does not</u> affect ECRP compliance
