



EASY TIPS TO BE RAIL SAFE IN ORANGE COUNTY

ORANGE COUNTY WILL SOON HAVE INCREASED FREQUENCY OF METROLINK PASSENGER-RAIL SERVICE. IT IS IMPORTANT TO LEARN AND TEACH RAIL SAFETY RULES.

1 TRACKS ARE FOR TRAINS!

They are private property. Walking, jogging or playing on or near the train tracks is considered trespassing and is illegal.

2 TRAINS WILL NOT ALWAYS BLOW WARNING HORNS.

Quiet Zones will soon be established in residential and business areas along the train tracks, so trains will no longer need to blow their horns.

3 WARNING SIGNS SAVE LIVES!

Approach all crossings with care and do not ignore any warning signs or gates.

- As a motorist, never drive around gates.
- As a pedestrian, always stop, look and listen for a train before crossing the tracks at a designated pedestrian crossing.

4 NEVER TRY TO BEAT A TRAIN!

Trains can take up to half a mile to reach a complete stop. Trains cannot swerve to avoid people or cars and cannot stop quickly enough to avoid a collision.
