


INTERSTATE 5 IMPROVEMENT PROJECT BETWEEN STATE ROUTE 55 AND STATE ROUTE 57

Project Information

Proposed Improvements

- Adds second high-occupancy vehicle (HOV) lane on Interstate 5 (I-5) between State Route 55 and State Route 57
 - Increase HOV lane capacity
 - Eliminate bottlenecks at HOV merge points
 - Reduce congestion/delay and improve air quality
- Generally constructed within existing right-of-way (ROW)
- \$42.4 million State Transportation Improvement Program funding, Regional Surface Transportation Program funding, and Measure M2 funding
- Project is currently in the environmental phase




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Project Schedule





Remaining Feasible HOV Project Alternatives

Alternative 1

No Build

Alternative 5B

- Remove existing barrier between the HOV lane and general purpose lanes
 - Add a second HOV lane adjacent to the existing HOV lane and restripe for continuous ingress/egress access
- Remove the I-5 Main Street HOV on- and off-ramp
 - Avoids ROW impacts
 - Higher than average accident rate
 - Low traffic volumes
- Way-finding freeway signage plan
 - Facilitate access to I-5 southbound Broadway/Main Street







First Street and Fourth Street Ramp Options (Eliminated)

No Build

Option A

- Close existing southbound (SB) I-5 First Street on-ramp
- Construct SB I-5 on-ramp at Fourth Street
- Close northbound (NB) I-5 "horseshoe" off-ramp to Mabury Street/First Street
- Eliminated from further consideration due to operational, traffic capacity, and community impact concerns from Caltrans and the City of Santa Ana

Option B

- Close existing SB I-5 First Street on-ramp
- Construct SB I-5 loop on-ramp at First Street
- Maintain NB I-5 "horseshoe" off-ramp to Mabury Street/First Street
- Eliminated from further consideration due to operational and design standard concerns from Caltrans for loop on-ramp
