### Eligibility Overview

- Agencies must meet eligibility requirements to be eligible for fair share and competitive M2 funds
- Download eligibility reference materials and CIP software at www.octa.net/cip2012.htm

### Eligibility Requirements For Measure M2

- Satisfy Maintenance of Effort (MOE) Requirements
- Adopt and update biennially a Pavement Management Plan (PMP)
- Agree to expend all Local Fair Share revenues received through Measure M2 within three years of receipt
- Adopt and provide an annual Expenditure Report to the OCTA
- Adopt and Update a Capital Improvement Program (CIP)
- Participate in Traffic Forums

## Eligibility Requirements For Measure M2 Continued

- Establish a policy requiring new development to pay its fair share of transportation-related improvements associated with their new development
- Provide the OCTA with a project Final Report within six months following completion of a project funded with Net Revenues
- Agree that Net Revenues shall not be used to supplant developer funding
- Consider, as a part of eligible jurisdiction's General Plan, land use and planning strategies that accommodate transit and non-motorized transportation

## Eligibility Requirements For Measure M2 Continued

- Comply with the conditions and requirements of the Orange County Congestion Management Program (CMP)
- Adopt and maintain a Local Signal Synchronization Plan
- Adopt a General Plan Circulation Element consistent with the Master Plan of Arterial Highways (MPAH)
- Submittals are due June 29, 2012

#### Eligibility Review Process

- CIP reviewed by OCTA
- TOC will review:
  - 1. Mitigation Fee Program
  - 2. Pavement Management Plan
  - 3. Expenditure Report
  - 4. Congestion Management Program (CMP)
  - 5. Local Signal Synchronization Plan

# Eligibility Items Due June 29, 2012

- Maintenance of Effort Certification
- Pavement Management Plan Certification for Even Year Agencies
- Capital Improvement Program (Electronic/Hard Copy)
- Eligibility Checklist (Appendix D)
  - No Supplanting Existing Commitments (Checklist)
  - Timely Expenditure of M2 Funds (Checklist)
  - Transit/ Non-motorized Transportation in General Plan (letter outlining approach)

### Maintenance of Effort (MOE) Certification

- Agencies must maintain expenditure of local funds for transportation purposes and not replace them with Measure M funds
- Submitted annually with June 29<sup>th</sup> submittals
- Use certification form included in eligibility guidelines (Appendix I)
- Submit the Maintenance of Effort Reporting Form with supporting budget documents showing General Fund expenditures
- Must meet or exceed MOE local discretionary funds
- Benchmark is unchanged from Measure M through 2014

# Pavement Management Plan (Even Year Agencies)

- Plan must be consistent with the countywide program
- Certification of the following criteria is required every two years (see schedule in Eligibility Manual Table 2-2):
  - Inventory of existing pavements and assessment of condition
  - Determine budget needs for replacement of deficient sections of pavement, regardless of funding availability
  - Discussion of budget and backlog issues in executive summary form

### Eligibility Checklist Items

- No Supplanting Existing Commitments
- Timely Expenditure of M2 Funds
- Transit/ Non-motorized Transportation in General Plan

#### Expenditure Report


- Filed within 6 months of end of Fiscal Year (December 31, 2012 for FY2011/12 expenditures)
- Include M2 fair share including interest,
   project list and M2 CTFP including interest
- Use reporting form included in eligibility guidelines (Appendix G)


#### Capital Improvement Program


- Seven-year Capital Improvement Program
  - FY12-13 through FY18-19
- Must include all Measure M-funded projects
- Include "Unfunded" projects that may use M1 or M2
- Microsoft Access software and support materials available for download at www.octa.net/cip2012.htm


#### Capital Improvement Program


- The Smart CIP is made up of 3 files:

  - cipdat1
- Save the files to c:/cip2012 for Access 2007 or newer versions
- Save the files to c:/cip2012\_ver2002 fo Access 2002 or 2003 users
- Click on the "cipapp" file
- Select your agency to load project data from prior year submittal
- Update your jurisdiction's information

















Seven Year Capital Improvement Program (Sorted by Name) Fiscal Years 2011/2012 through 2017/2018

#### CIP Submittal

- Change the file extension to cipdat.md if using Access 2002 or 2003
- Email the cipdat file to May Hout at mhout@octa.net
- Print a copy of the PMP Reports, Eligibility Checklist (Appendix D) and MOE (Appendix I) and submit with your package by June 29, 2012
- Submit printed and electronic copy of CIP by June 29, 2012
- Obtain Council/Board approval
- Submit final CIP to OCTA by 8/13/12 if original submission was a draft

#### Lessons Learned

- Save CIP software properly
- Include "Unfunded" projects
- Add signal and competitive projects to CIP
- Include fund key with MOE budget
- Sign all forms
- Include Executive Summary of PMP

### Future Eligibility Items

- Congestion Management Program (Due 2013)
- MPAH Consistency/Circulation Element (Due 2013)
- Mitigation Fee Program (Due 2013)
- Local Signal Synchronization Plan (Due 2014)

#### Important Dates to Remember

- June Formalize submittal package, limited support available
- June 29, 2012 Deadline to submit Eligibility Package based upon checklist (Renewed Measure M Eligibility Guidelines Appendix D)
- August 13, 2012 Last date to submit adopted
   CIP
- December 31, 2012 Deadline for Expenditure Report

### Schedule Changes for 2012

- Mitigation Fee Program are now submitted biennially instead of annually (2013)
- MPAH Consistency/Circulation Element are also now submitted biennially instead of annually (2013)
