The Orange County Transportation Authority has begun construction of the Placentia Avenue and Kraemer Boulevard undercrossings. In accordance with federal railroad safety regulations, residents should expect to hear an increase in the frequency of train horns because of construction activities on and around the railroad tracks, regardless of quiet zone designation.

Regular work hours are Monday through Saturday, 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.

The following construction activities are anticipated to begin during the next two weeks:

Placentia Avenue

- Site preparation activities along the BNSF corridor continue, including grading, clearing & grubbing.
- Wall preparation within the BNSF corridor will begin with drilling and setting beams
- Confirmation of Utility work relocation continues
- Sewer line work on Crowther begins shortly
- Completion of vegetation clearing along east side of Placentia (Industrial Way to Crowther)

Kraemer Boulevard

- Work continues to address traffic mitigation measures associated with the **closure of Kraemer Blvd. and Crowther Ave scheduled for 1 a.m. Monday, January 30.** Detour maps are attached.
- Initiate noise monitoring devices installation & tree removal along the BNSF corridor & along public parkways
- Due to the intersection closure, some bus stops on Rts. 129 and 213 will be eliminated. Please click link for bus rider alerts: [Riders Alerts](#)

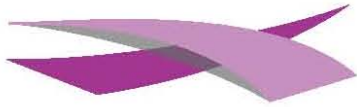

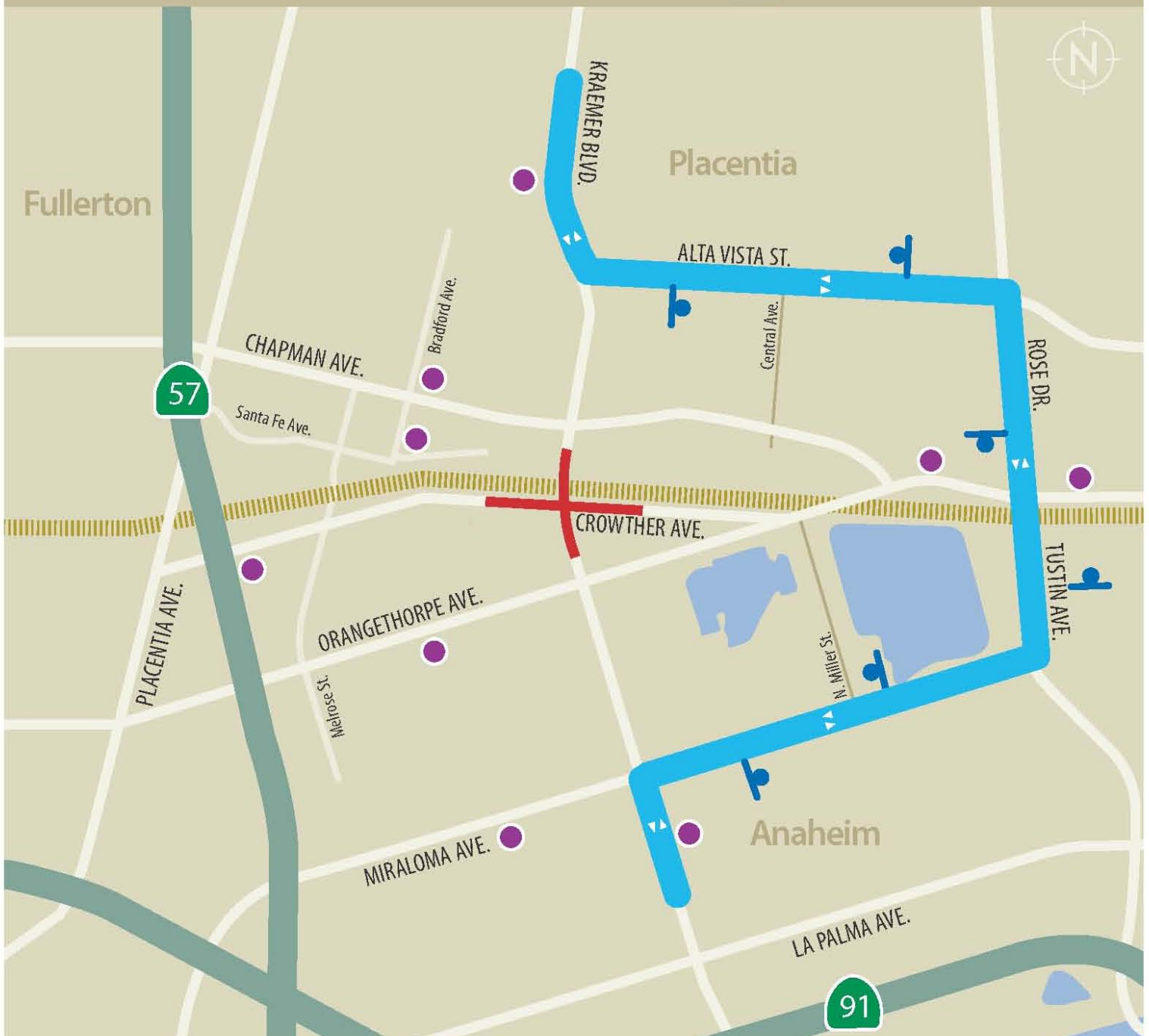
Kraemer Boulevard Undercrossing

-  Radar Speed Advisory



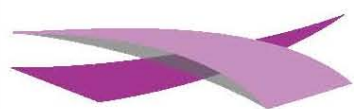

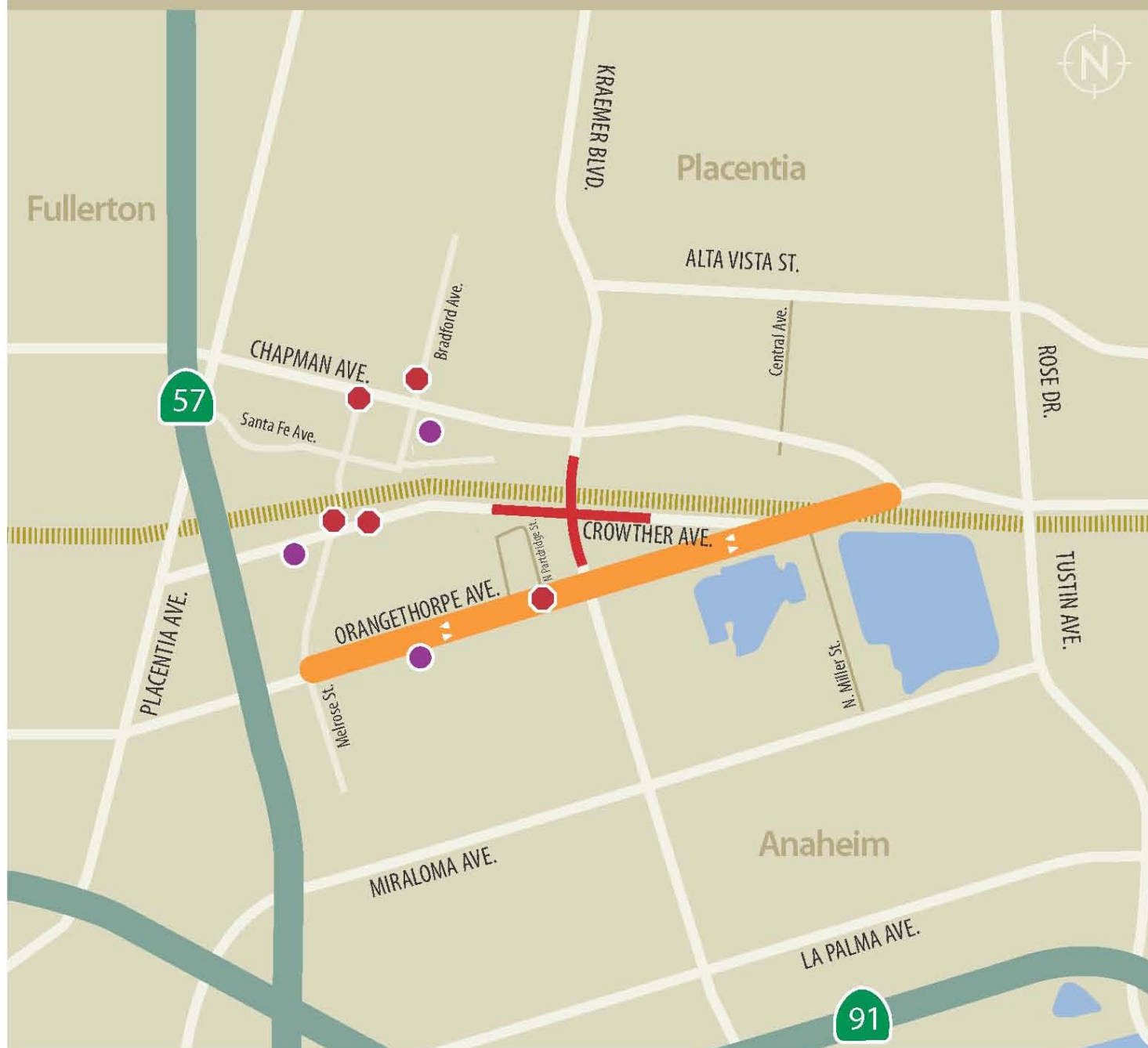
Kraemer Boulevard Undercrossing
