



Eastbound 4th St. Closures

WHAT: Rolling lane closures to accommodate overhead wire installation. Rolling closures will be across the eastbound lane of several block segments. As crews complete a segment, the eastbound lane will be reopened to traffic and street parking and crews will begin work at the next segment.

WHERE: Eastbound 4th Street, from Ross Street and Mortimer Street.

WHEN: The rolling closures are anticipated to start as early as Monday, June 3. Rolling closures will continue approximately through the week, 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. each day. One segment will be closed at a time.

The schedule is subject to change due to inclement weather or unforeseen operational issues. Work activities are weather and site condition dependent. If a rain event occurs on the anticipated start date, the construction activity will be delayed until the weather clears. This work may be loud.

WHY: Crews are installing overhead wires that form part of the overhead wire system. The OC Streetcar will be powered by electricity from the overhead wire system, known as an Overhead Contact System (OCS).
